

Dear Friends of the Work of Gerhard Reisch,

You are warmly invited to participate in the first Symposium, as well as in either or both of the Seminars, from Monday 15th to Friday 19th October 2012 in Kloster Fischingen in Switzerland.

Introduction:

The impulse for the Symposium arose out of the question: *How can the Work of Gerhard Reisch serve Humanity and the Earth during the next decades?* This question is not only relevant for long standing friends of the Work, but also for those who will be seeking this Work in the future. The Symposium was conceived already in 2009 for Autumn 2011. The challenge of finding an appropriate venue led to a postponement until Autumn 2012. We have now found a wonderful venue, with a very clear energy, in the *Benedictine Kloster Fischingen* (with full board and lodging) in the international region of Lake Constance in Switzerland. The proximity of Zurich Airport (40 minutes drive) is a real advantage, since there are friends of the Work of Gerhard Reisch in 36 countries worldwide.

Content of the Symposium:

We will design and coordinate the Symposium so that all participants can share and develop their relationship to the Work, their creative interaction with the Work and their contributions to future tasks, individually and communally. As we make preparations, we hope that we may rely upon your support, indeed your trust and your independent contributions. We will provisionally design a process for the work together, which will create a free open space for the presence of the spiritual realms. Registered participants will receive further information in good time before the Symposium.

The Seminars:

We are aware that many friends will be particularly anticipating that this will be an opportunity to further advance their schooling work with original pictures and texts. It is, however, not the task of the Symposium to directly serve this need. Therefore, we have planned Seminars 1 and 2 for those who do not wish to miss such an opportunity. It is also possible to attend the Seminars without participating in the Symposium. In addition Symposium participants can freely decide whether they want to attend the Seminars. *Ilse K. Müller* und *Christopher Bee* will be responsible for the respective content of these independent Seminars, which, although different, will complement each other. Their individual experience and methodological practice are widely known. Registered participants will receive further information in good time before the Seminars. We are also open to your questions, suggestions, proposals or special wishes.

Community Building, Board and Lodging:

In order to promote a process of community building during the Symposium, a minimum of two overnight stays in the Kloster (or in the immediate vicinity) and in total six meals for every participant. Also two meals a day are understood to be integral to each Seminar.

All the rooms in the Kloster are lovingly cared for. The wholefood catering in the Refectory is first class. Lunch will be generous, whilst Supper will be lighter. Vegetarians will also enjoy good food. Everywhere in the Kloster fresh spring water and apples (courtesy of the Foundation) will always be available. Further refreshments can be purchased according to need during breaks.

You can reserve extra overnight stays and meals freely according to your personal needs. We wish, however, to indicate that we intend that each day of the Symposium and the Seminars will commence punctually at 9.00 am and end no earlier than 21.30 pm. Please be punctual and respect these times wherever you coming from and going to. So, if you are not staying over the night before, please organise your travel arrangements so as to be sure to be on time at the beginning of the day.

Benefit Concert, Exhibition and "limited assistance for friends in need":

"Earthwards" comprises *Jehanne Mehta*, *Rob Mehta* and *Will Mercer*. The lyrics (in English, but also some in French and German) and Music by *Jehanne Mehta* are unique, moving and deeply refreshing. Everyone is welcome at Concert as also the Exhibition of Original Pictures, which will be open beforehand. Voluntary contributions to the costs (guideline € 20 / Sfr 25) will be collected after the Concert to enable us to provide some "limited assistance for friends in need", who otherwise would not be able to attend the Symposium.

Finances, Payment in Advance and Conditions of Cancellation:

Payment of all fees and expenses will be asked for in advance. In the case of cancellation a 100% refund of monies paid will be possible up to 90 days before midnight on Saturday 13th October. (According to circumstances an appropriate administration fee can be levied). Thereafter, the prevailing Conditions of Cancellation come into force in agreement with our hosting partners in Fischingen. The reason for the advance payment is to enable the Foundation to financially secure its commitments to its organisational partners as also to the participants. Above all else, we can only guarantee bed reservations in the strict order in which the registration payments are received. Individual questions can be addressed at any time.

The goal of the Foundation is not to make a profit, but to cover all costs; because the Foundation works without any capital. Surpluses will be directed towards enabling "limited assistance for friends in need". Members of the board of trustees gift their work for the Symposium, Seminars, Exhibition and the Concert. In accordance with their personal requirements, participants may request receipts for gifts, conference costs or further training costs.

Your Participation:

Please read the attached documents carefully. Do not be afraid to ask questions about anything which is not clear. Within the given structural conditions please decide if and how you want to, and can, participate. Don't hesitate too long to follow through with your registration and payments; because when the 25 two bed rooms in the Kloster and the 12 rooms in Gasthaus Sternen have been reserved, participation could be more difficult, possibly more expensive as well. We are reckoning with some 50 participants for the Symposium. This number is appropriate for our meeting space as well as for the anticipated course for the Symposium. Therefore, we ask you please, to give us your feedback latest before the 31st of May 2012.

In the name of the Life Work of Gerhard Reisch, we joyfully look forward to your collaboration during the Symposium, as also to your possible participation in the Seminars,
