Training and research

In his final testament, Gerhard Reisch confirmed that his entire collection of pictures and writings has no commercial value, but should be kept together and made accessible to interested persons for spiritual scientific purposes. By establishing the Gerhard Reisch Foundation in 1981, AnneGret Reisch has ensured that there is a legal basis in the charitable domain to preserve his legacy and share this with others.

The picture collection is accessible by appointment and with accompaniment at the archive of the Gerhard Reisch Foundation in order to view original pictures, to ask questions or to continue personal research. Original pictures are loaned to trusted friends, when doing so can contribute to group work, seminars and conferences.

Subtle interaction with pictures naturally benefits from work with originals. However, through reproductions, a person can gain inner access to the images, at any time, in any space, alone or in a group. The modalities and methods that can be used personally or through accompaniment are as diverse as the spectrum of modern spiritual scientific research.

The Work deals with themes of spiritual development and schooling of human beings, as also the spiritual scientific exploration of the evolution of the Earth and Humanity. Thus it cannot be a product of mass consumption. Foundress AnneGret Reisch advised that Gerhard Reisch intended that his Life Work should only be encountered in freedom.

Colleagues in different countries are constantly gaining experience in their independent accompaniment of groups working with original pictures and reproductions. Training programmes mediating content and methods for working with the images and mantric texts in, i. a. pedagogical, artistic, therapeutic, palliative and pedagogical fields are also facilitated by the Gerhard Reisch Foundation. Participants often set up their own intervision groups which involve work with original pictures or reproductions.

The Gerhard Reisch Foundation focuses on the development of future possibilities of mediating the Work of Gerhard Reisch by archiving, publishing and promoting initiatives of friends interacting with the Work, in Europe but also worldwide; increasingly in connection with the advancing development of modern media such as internet, digital printing and flat screen presentation.

Through application of original images and publications, various research and further training initiatives are developing in fields such as the Arts, Applied Therapies, Biographical Development, Community Building, Culture accompanying Dying and Death, Formative Forces, Geomancy, Healing, High Festivals, Nature Being, Nursing, Palliative Care, Pastoral Medicine, Reincarnation, Schooling on a Path of Knowledge, Seasons, Youth Education. Circles of friends from around the world communicate their schooling initiatives in various fields of human and social education. The number of colleagues with independent experience of accompanying group work with original images and reproductions is steadily growing. An overview of Foundation involvement in the realms of culture and education can also be found in the newsletters "Wayfarer" for friends of the Work of Gerhard Reisch, which are also archived on the website www.gerhardreisch.com.

The Work of Gerhard Reisch is currently living in 44 countries worldwide: Argentina, Armenia, Australia, Belgium, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Chile, China, Denmark, Germany, Finland, France, India, Ireland, Iceland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Canada, Croatia, Lebanon, New Zealand, Netherlands, Norway, Austria, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, Scotland, Sweden, Switzerland, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, South Africa, Czech Republic, Ukraine, Hungary, United Kingdom and United States of America.

Every year many bilingual (German / English) copies of the portfolios "A Path of Knowledge in Pictures", "From the World of Elemental Beings" and "Death and Incarnation", as well as "A Book of the Dead" and "Between Two Worlds" continue to be distributed around the world by the Gerhard Reisch Publishing in Germany. Translations of "A Path of Knowledge in Pictures" and "A Book of the Dead" are also available in English, French, Italian, Dutch, Portuguese, Romanian, Spanish and Russian, which can be made available upon request.

As always the entire Life Work of Gerhard Reisch is carried by all human beings, both near and far, who experience thereto a personal relationship and in their individual ways work with it, also by using the existing publications!
